#### HE'LL BE BACK

Miami Symphony Orchestra (MISO) and music director and conductor **Eduardo Marturet** have agreed to extend their partnership through July 31, 2017.

Marturet's "breadth of repertoire, passion and precision bring an exciting level of quality to the cultural life of Miami," MISO chairman **Rafael Diaz-Balart** says in a statement. "We want to be able to count on his direction and leadership."

The Venezuelan-born Marturet was handed the orchestra's baton from its founder, the late **Manuel Ochoa**, in 2006. Founded in 1989, the orchestra now has more than 80 musicians. Its season closes with on May 7 at Gusman Concert Hall, 1314 Miller Dr., Coral Gables, and May 8 at the Lincoln Theatre, 541 Lincoln Rd., Miami Beach. Tickets are \$15 to \$60.
