Orchestra appoints concertmaster, 24

The Miami Symphony Orchestra has appointed Daniel Andai as concertmaster. The orchestra has been using rotating concertmasters for the last couple seasons.

Andai, 24, is a member of the UBS Verbier Orchestra and Chamber Orchestra of Europe. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in music from Lynn University in Boca Raton and holds a professional arts degree and master's degree in orchestral performance from the Manhattan School of Music. This fall he will pursue a doctorate in music at the University of Miami's Frost School of Music.

"Daniel brings exceptional talent, experience and musical sensitivity to his position as concertmaster," MSO music director Eduardo Marturet said in a released statement. "He will be a great asset for the artistic future of our organization."
